



9. 1. Project : Ya_All Peer Counselling Centre

April 2022 - March 2023

Partner Organization: Mariwala Health Initiative

This project focused on mental health advocacy by providing therapy sessions through tele-counselling as well as one-on-one sessions, including awareness programmes with adolescents, children, transmen, youth and children living in homes, people with disabilities, young people living with HIV, and the LGBTQI+ community in Manipur.

9.2. Project: Crisis Support for the LGBTQIA Community

Duration: April 2022 - December 2022

Partner Organization: YouthLead

The project aimed to protect and expand visibility for the LGBTQIA+ community in our society by strengthening the Crisis Support System with the availability of short-stay facilities for individuals in the community who have faced discrimination or violence and ostracized from their homes or community. The Crisis Support Centre also provided basic health care services, including HIV testing, emergency medication, mental health counselling, legal support, training sessions, events, and a drop-in centre. It also built a peer support network from the community to extend the reach beyond and understand their needs.




9.4. Project: Digital Advocacy on Comprehensive Sexuality Education in Manipur

The project was a community-led initiatives by empowering Young People Living with HIV through advocacy to bring their voices together and bridge the gaps within the community itself. Assessing their needs through group interaction sessions among YPLHIV and providing nutritional supplements to them as per their requirements.

9.8 . Project: Strengthening Support System of Transgender Youth in Manipur under "T-Youth" Project

Duration: April 2019 - Ongoing

Partner Organization: Department of social Welfare, Government of Manipur

Under the Integrated Child Protection Scheme (ICPS), carried out a project which focused on capacity building among peers by conducting educational workshop sessions about the basic understanding of mental health, gender, sexuality, and livelihood among peers, parents, and professionals. Using football and sports as a tool for inclusion through community meet-up. Apart from this Ya_All organised free health camps with professionals.

9.9. Project: Rainbow Trust Centre

Duration: April 2022 - March 2023

Partner Organization: Department of Social Welfare, Government of Manipur

Under the scheme for prevention of alcoholism and substance abuse, a Rehabilitation Centre for Transgender (Boys/Men) called "Rainbow Trust Centre" was established, to provide a safe and caring space for addicts to recover from their addiction, with the availability of 15-bedded facility. Rainbow Trust Centre focused on psychosocial rehabilitation and intervention.

9.10. Project: The Birds and Bees Talk

Duration: June 2021 to May 2022 Partner Organization: Plan India

This project aimed to break the silence around Sexual and Reproductive Health, Mental Health, and Well-being by building up trusted bonds with adolescents and young people through friendly interaction and discussion sessions with them. It also provided lifesaving information through online and physical workshops, and encourage them to take responsibility for their own well-being. A mental health helpline called 'Talking Birds' was launched and provided Psychosocial support.

Date: 24th June 2022

Partner Organization: Transforming Communities for Inclusion (TCI)

It was a one-day consultation workshop, and the purpose of the consultation was to understand the challenges of forced detention and isolation of individuals with disabilities at rehabs, wards, institutions, and homes during emergencies and beyond in the name of care and support.

12.1. Flagship Event: Queer Games 2022

Date: 12th July 2023 & 13th July 2023

Queer Games is a fundraiser and flagship event of Ya_All, where we use sport and game as a tool for raising LGBTQIA+ awareness and to mainstream in India.

The 5th Edition of Queer Games 2022 was held for two consecutive days at Tribal Research Institute (TRI) and Play 7 Turf Ground. On the first day, BTS Festa Screening and dance performance were held in collaboration with Manipur BTS Army. The next day, Football match was held in which four teams competed each other. The Queer Games 2022 ended with tree plantation at the Shelter Space, Khurai by Colin Shonk, High Commission of Canada in India.

13. YA_ALL SHELTER SPACE

Ya_All successfully runs a shelter space for the LGBTQIA+ community to strengthen the crisis support system with the availability of 15-bedded short-stay facility for individuals who have faced discrimination or violence at home, who are ostracised from their homes or community, and who are in need of support and a short-stay for living. The space also provided basic health care services, including HIV testing, emergency medication, mental health counselling, legal support, training sessions, events, and a drop-in centre.

The space is a safe space for the community to come together and a space for diaglogue and discussions on LGBTQIA community including regular training sessions, events, etc., and its diverse growth, challenges and way forward.


